NORTH TEXAS—One of the top five cultural centers in the nation, North Texas will celebrate the thirty-second annual Obelisk Awards on November 17 with a luncheon ceremony in the International Ballroom of the Fairmont Dallas.

Katherine Wagner, CEO of the prestigious arts organization founded by the late entrepreneur and art collector Raymond Nasher, has issued a call for Obelisk nominations from both the business community and individuals by Friday, May 29, 2020.
