

# OMOT Submission Categories

Each artist must select the appropriate category when submitting their work. Liaisons may determine how many entries are allowed per category.

## Literary Arts Categories

<b>Literary Art Category</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>10-Word Story</b>	A story containing precisely 10 words (punctuation not counted)
<b>Creative Non-Fiction</b>	Non-fictional writing of no more than 650 words that uses factual information (e.g. essays, biographies, memoirs, etc.)
<b>Fictional Short Story</b>	A fictional story of no more than 650 words
<b>Open Verse Poetry</b>	Poetry of any style or structure; no more than 500 words
<b>Corporate Collaboration</b>	Short story of no more than 650 words that are written by 3 or more employees.
<b>AI Literature</b>	Literary works that include any amount of AI technology and are no more than 650 words. Prompts required as part of submission.

# Visual Art Categories

Visual Art Category	Description
<b>Painting</b>	Oils, acrylics, watercolors, and other paints
<b>Drawing/Printmaking/Works on Paper</b>	drawings, prints, and collage on paper
<b>Black &amp; White Photography</b>	Images created with a digital or film camera printed in black and white; Must be "straight" photography, with only minor digital enhancements
<b>Color Photography</b>	Images created with a digital or film camera printed in color; Must be "straight" photography, with only minor digital enhancements
<b>Digital Art</b>	Includes art that is made using digital technology
<b>AI Art</b>	Artwork that uses any amount of AI technology
<b>Sculpture</b>	Objects such as castings, constructions, and assemblages
<b>Ceramics, Wood &amp; Glass</b>	Objects such as carvings, woodturning, pottery and fired clay, mosaic, and glass – not including sculpture
<b>Jewelry &amp; Metal</b>	Objects such as jewelry and metal works – not including sculpture
<b>Mixed Media</b>	Works using more than one medium
<b>Textiles &amp; Fiber</b>	Objects utilizing fabric, yarn, thread, or textiles, including but not limited to: weaving, quilting, needlework-embroidery, needlepoint, crocheting, tatting, knitting, sewing, basketry, wearable art, rugs, and surface designs such as batik
<b>Video/Film/Animation</b>	Film, documentary, and 2D or 3D animation of any kind
<b>Corporate Collaboration</b>	Visual art created by 3 or more employees (e.g., a collaborative painting, mosaic, sculpture, or collage)
